What are the side effects associated with radiotherapy?

Can my child have radiotherapy without a general anaesthetic? How can we support them to do this?

How can I prepare my child for radiotherapy?

Will my child feel anything during or after radiotherapy?

Can my child still go to school or nursery?

Can we arrange treatment around school/nursery so my child can have access to a 'normal' day during treatment?

We want to help parents and carers to ask the right questions and be confident to open a dialogue with their children's health care professionals around radiotherapy.
